

# The **ECO-DEPOTS** are back!

Kent Regional Service Commission is proud to announce the return of the eco-depots. In collaboration with Southeast Eco360, this **FREE** service will allow you to get rid of bulky, dangerous and other products at a location near you.

## ✓ BRING US THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

Maximum quantity equivalent to a half-ton truck or utility trailer.  
We ask residents to sort their load by type of material to facilitate unloading.

- Appliances and furniture;
- Construction and demolition waste **(make sure it's easy and safe to transport)**;
- Household hazardous waste;
- Small motorized tools **(must be emptied of oil and gasoline)**;
- Wood palettes **(limit of 5 per resident)**;
- Marine debris **(limit of 5 traps and 10 buoys per resident)**;
- Glass **(the glass gathered during these collections will be recycled)**;
- Tires;
- Ash;
- and more!



## ✗ THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTED:

- Auto parts **(except tires)**;
- Regular waste eligible for regular roadside collection **(blue, green and clear bags)**;
- Bulk waste not sorted by type of material;
- Commercial waste.

In order to stop the spread of COVID-19, we ask that you **be patient when you visit the mobile eco-depots and stay in your vehicle.** Eco360 employees will be happy to get your items out of your vehicle for you.
