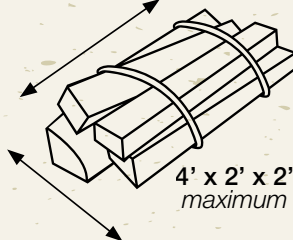


CONSTRUCTION and DEMOLITION MATERIALS

Bulky waste pickups allow residents to dispose of small quantities of construction and demolition waste. The service is intended mostly for small renovation projects. **We will take up to five (5) bundles of these types of materials per household, per pickup.**

Acceptable materials include wood, asphalt shingles, siding, carpets, and pipes if the bundles are within the following dimensions: 4' x 2' x 2' (1.2 m x 0.6 m x 0.6 m) in size, each weighing no more than 50 lb (23 kg).

Bundles, bags or boxes
Maximum of 5 per pickup



Careful with these items!

Windows and mirrors

When compacted, glass can shatter, leaving a substantial amount of debris, or worse, even injure the people handling it.

Before disposing of windows and mirrors:

- Break the glass in advance.
- Place it in a box and write "broken glass" on the box.
- Attach the frame in a 4' x 2' x 2' (1.2m x 0.6m x 0.6m) bundle.

Wood

We accept small quantities of wood grouped in bundles.

Before disposing of wood:

- Remove all nails.
- Attach the wood in 4' x 2' x 2' (1.2m x 0.6m x 0.6m) bundles.
- Each bundle should weigh no more than 50 lb (23 kg).

These procedures have been implemented to ensure the safety of waste collectors and the general public and guarantee more efficient and timely service.



Did you know?

Waste that can be placed in a bag can probably be picked up during regular garbage collection.

We will pick up one clear bag with construction and demolition waste every two weeks (on clear-bag collection weeks) to help you get rid of the materials. Examples include insulation, small pieces of wood, flooring, etc.
