Job description

The responsibilities of the Planning and Development Technician are as follows:

- Enforcing the Planning Act, regulations and by-laws.
- Participating in the preparation of preliminary plans and community profiles.
- Participating in the development of urban, semi-urban or rural development programs.
- Conducting research, surveys and inventories on the various socio-economic, physical and environmental aspects of development.
- Conducting site inspections of construction and development projects.
- Developing and executing development sketches.
- Participating in the development of municipal plans and local or regional planning projects.
- Participating in the development and amendment of municipal by-laws and planning and development standards (in collaboration with planners, lawyers, and community stakeholders).
- Collaborating with planners and other officials on complex planning issues.
- Participating in the preparation of a report on subdivision files.
- Developing an awareness of the concepts and principles of sustainable development.
- Any other duties as assigned by the Director.

Qualifications

The desired candidate will have started his/her training in a post-secondary institution in a field related to architecture, urban planning, geography, engineering, or any other related field and will possess the following skills:

- Good knowledge of the NB Community Planning Act.
- Have a good knowledge of French and English.
- Familiarity with the Kent Region.
- Have an aptitude for science and technical drawing.
