that can be plugged in or needs batteries

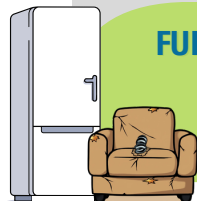


## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Fridge, couch, mattress,
