6. Criteria for Identifying Recreational Infrastructure in the Kent Region

A working document was sent beforehand, to put the discussion into context. Here is a summary of the points to bring in order to create fair and realistic criteria.

- Population density as well as the amount of recreational infrastructure in a community should be taken into consideration when creating criteria.
- The use and capacity of an infrastructure.

- The exclusivity of an infrastructure should call it regional, without however not stopping it since the capacity should also play a role.
- The number of infrastructures of the same nature in a sub-region or locally should be taken into account. Example: golden age clubs.
- The source of funds and financing should be included as a criterion.
- Ease of access in terms of geographical position is important.
- Accessibility for people with reduced mobility should be a criterion in order to be inclusive and safe.
- At the level of the criteria, it would be important to distinguish between recreational infrastructures and those which are also emergency centers or which occupy other roles in the community. Especially since when sharing the cost of these infrastructures, it would be important to study that the cost sharing is fair in the proposal for the other roles to be occupied by the infrastructure in question.
- It will be important to extend the criteria on external infrastructure.

7. New Business

Remuneration for committee members is \$100 per meeting, while the chair of the committee will receive \$125 per meeting. When the committee is able to meet in person, the mileage for travel is set at \$0.45 per kilometer. Remuneration is in the form of direct deposit at the beginning of every month and a form will be sent to you by email.
